ANNUAL REPORT 2016 – 2017

HIGHLIGHTS

The Executive Committee of the Canadian Home Economics Foundation, based in Winnipeg, Manitoba, held six (6) regular meetings during the 2016 - 2017 fiscal year ending April 30. Nine provincial/regional trustees chair awards committees and distribute information about the Foundation to local meetings and conferences. The Canadian Home Economics Foundation operates with volunteers and no paid staff.

The 36th Board of Trustees meeting was held on October 17, 2016 at Eleanor Cassels' residence in Winnipeg MB. The 36th Annual Meeting and Donor Recognition of the Canadian Home Economics Foundation was held October 22, 2016 in conjunction with the Manitoba Association of Home Economists Annual Meeting at the Caboto Centre in Winnipeg, MB.

From May 1, 2016 to April 30, 2017 funding of \$35,395 was approved for 26 grants and awards across Canada in the areas of education, public service and post-secondary education and training. Donations and bequests totaled \$38,967.

A motion to approve a Limitations of Liability disclaimer to include with applications was approved in June 2016.

The Foundation approved the addition of social media accounts after a presentation by Anthony Ngayan who spoke about the potential benefits of social media for CHE Foundation. Anthony currently volunteers to post and monitor the accounts in conjunction with the Executive Communications and Development trustees.

A new CHE Foundation email address has been created for grants: grants@chef-fcef.ca. All documents will be updated with this address.

A motion was approved to change the name of <u>Website</u> – <u>Emmie Oddie Award</u> to <u>www.homefamily.net</u> – <u>Emmie Oddie Award</u>.

The criteria for the Graduate Student Award was updated by motion to permit part-time students to apply for the award.

Six terms of office on the Board of Trustees end at the Board of Trustees meeting in October 2017. On the Executive, Gail Watson, as treasurer and Donna Bulow, as chairperson, have agreed to extend their terms to 2020. Provincial/regional trustees Mary Leah de Zwart, BC has agreed to a two-year extension to 2019, and Marie Slusar, AB has agreed to a one-year extension to 2018. Murielle Gaudet, NB has resigned having served the Foundation for ten years. The Executive thanks Murielle for her dedicated service to the Foundation.

We note with sadness the death of Isabel Palmeter of Nova Scotia. Isabel served as a dedicated Trustee of the Foundation for 35 years.

We are pleased to recognize the Ontario Home Economists in Business Association as a new Patron of the Foundation. We appreciate the generous gift of support, but are saddened to learn that the association has disbanded.
